



Member Audits

Each year the SAMRT randomly selects 10% of the membership to submit verification of earning the required continuing education credits, verification of working the minimum amount of medical radiation technology practice hours and verification of having the required professional liability insurance, as declared on the SAMRT initial application and/or annual renewal.

Continuing Education Credits

Members must submit proof of earning a minimum of ten (10) continuing education credits from the period of December 1 - November 30 of the previous year.

Practice Hours

Members must verify having worked the minimum amount of required medical radiation technology practice hours by having their manager/human resource representative complete the SAMRT Verification of Hours document.

Professional Liability Insurance (PLI)

Members must verify that they have the required PLI as described in the SAMRT Regulatory Bylaws (18. *All members who practice are required to be insured against liability for professional negligence in an amount that is at least \$1,000,000 per incident and \$5,000,000 per year*). For members who obtain PLI through their CAMRT membership, a copy of the CAMRT membership card or receipt is sufficient.
